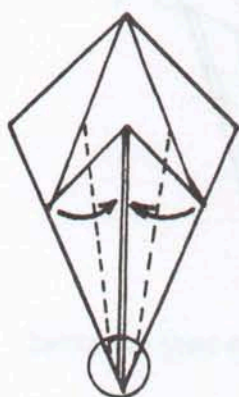
1. Preliminary base. Squash one flap, and repeat behind.



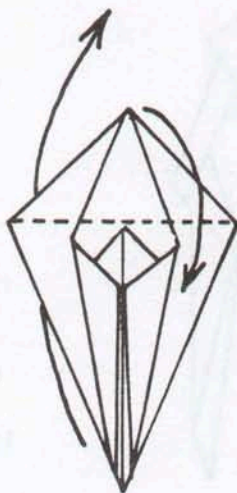

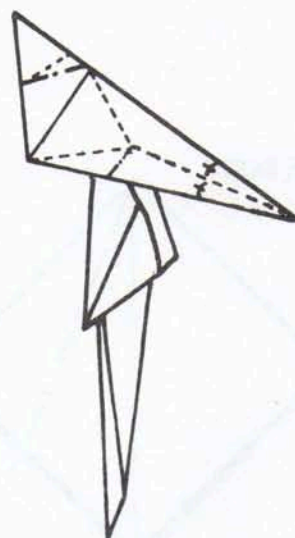
8. Rabbit ear, top layer only. Miss the points at the bottom.



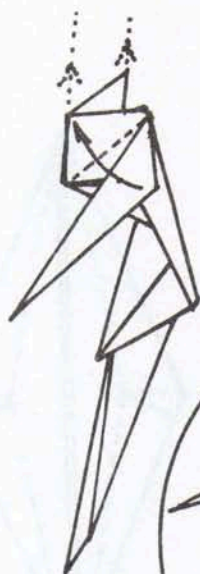
9. Fold the model in half, incorporating outside reverse fold.



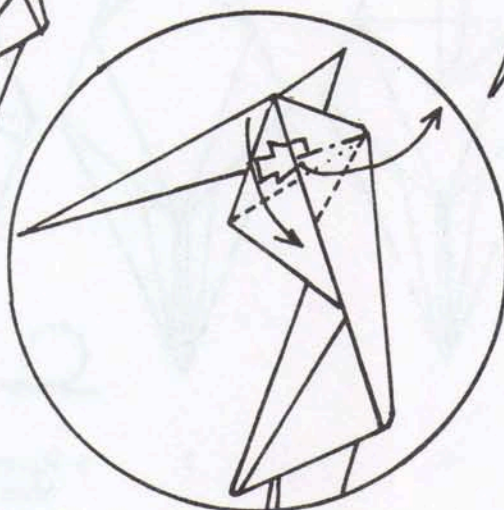

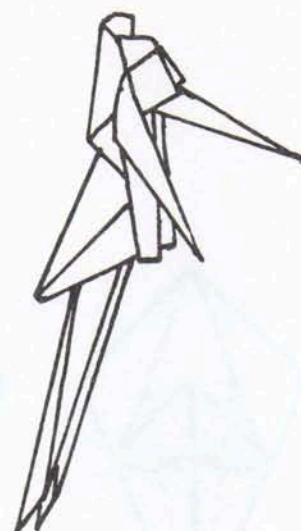
11. Crimp. Rabbit ear. Two angles at the top are divided unevenly. Repeat behind.

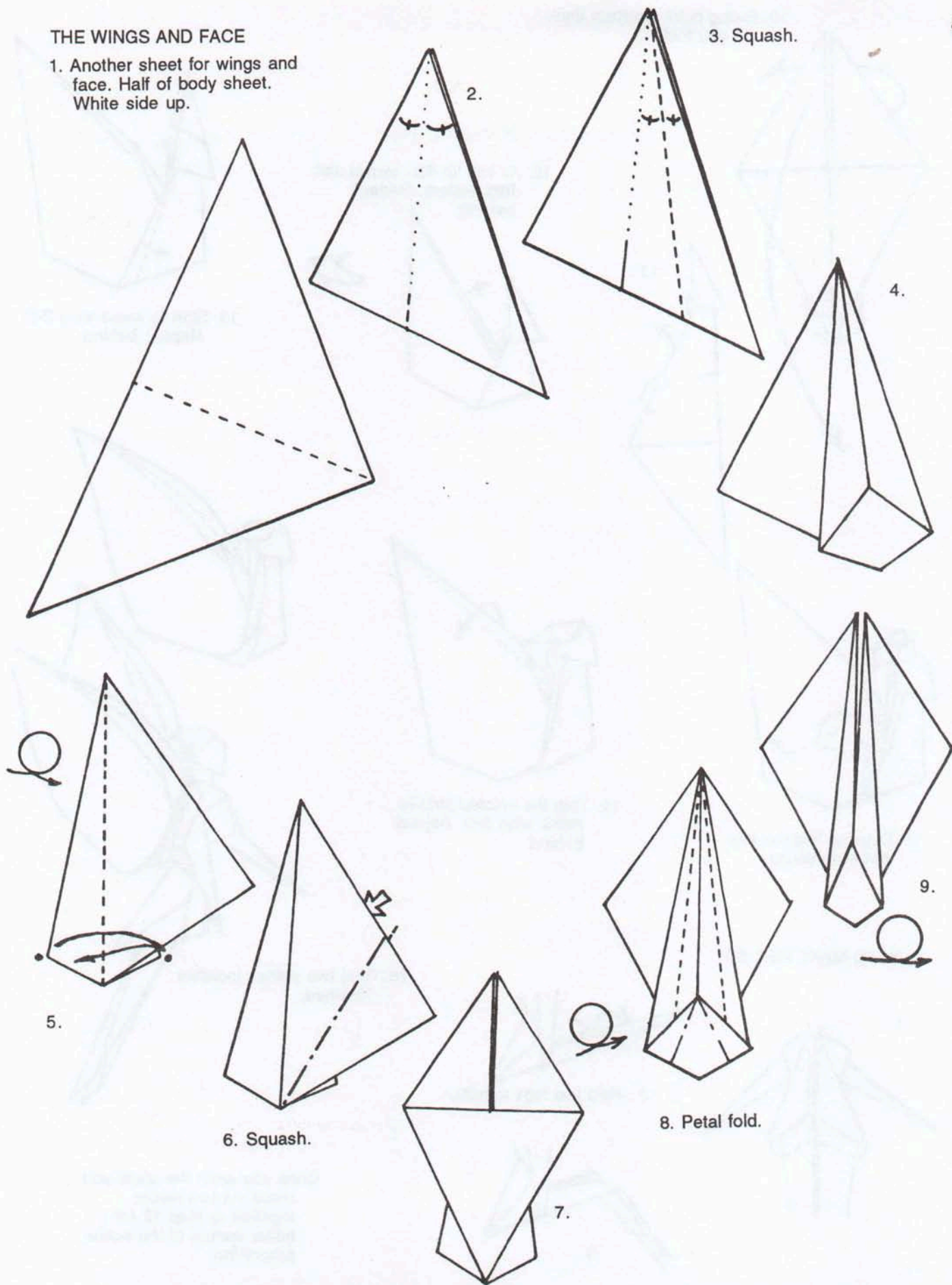

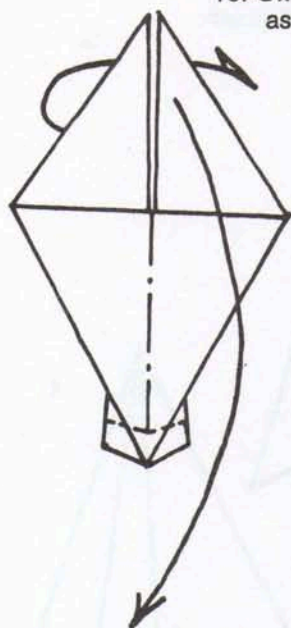

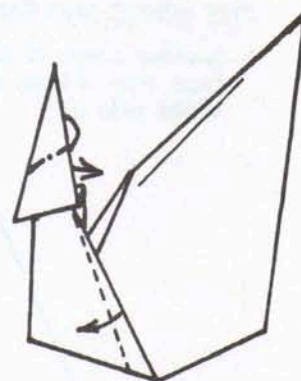

10. Swing point out from back as you fold.

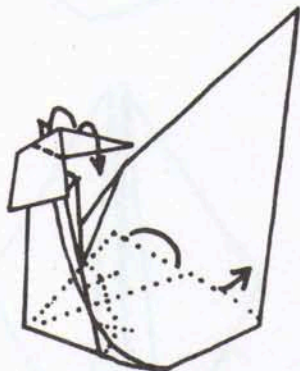


12. As you lift flap, swivel and fold bottom. Repeat behind.

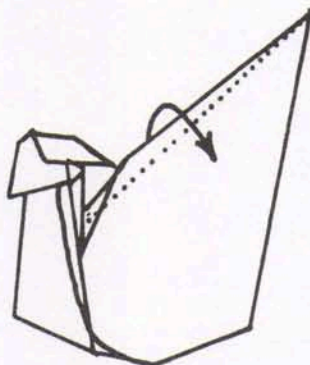

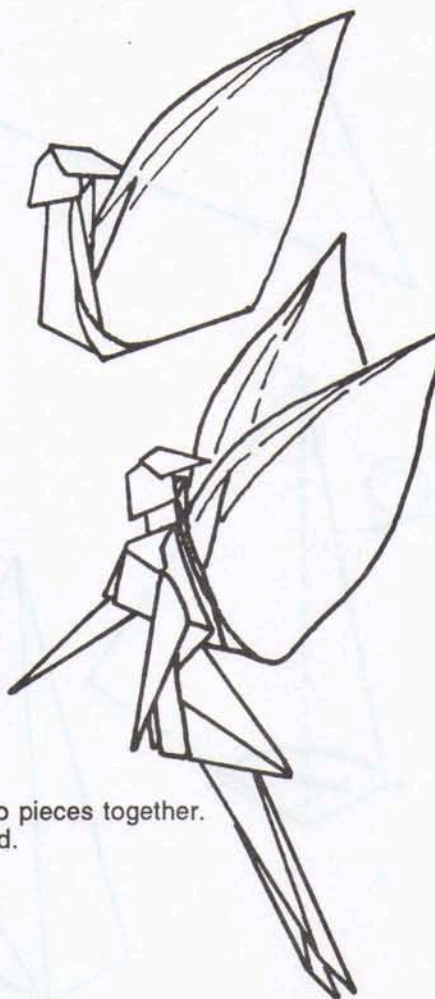

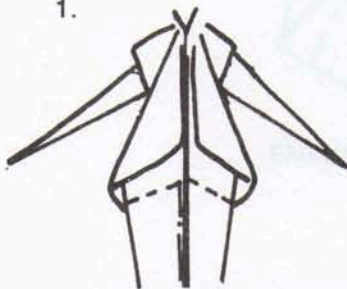
15. Turn the colored strip to make wing 3-D. Repeat behind.

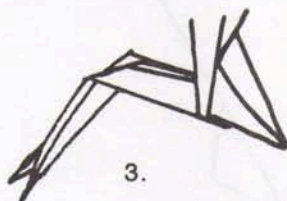
