The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) through the Ministry of Economy and Finance, has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of Road Asset Management Project II (RAMP-II), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Road Survey Equipment on a Vehicle, Software and Training.
2. The Ministry of Public Works and Transport now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Supply and Delivery of One Survey Equipment on a vehicle, software and training.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the ICB as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers dated January 2011, revised July 2014 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **3:00_{PM}, 03 January 2018**.

The Bidders are requested to submit as part of their bids the statement of Ethical Conduct and Fraud and Corruption and in case of misleading information or non-adherence to the Fraud and Corruption provision of the bidding documents, the Bidder shall be pursued by the Royal Government of Cambodia or the World Bank.

The Royal Government of Cambodia and World Bank will respectively declare a firm ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract funded by the Royal Government of Cambodia and the World Bank, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent, coercive or collusive practices in competing for or in executing a contract.
