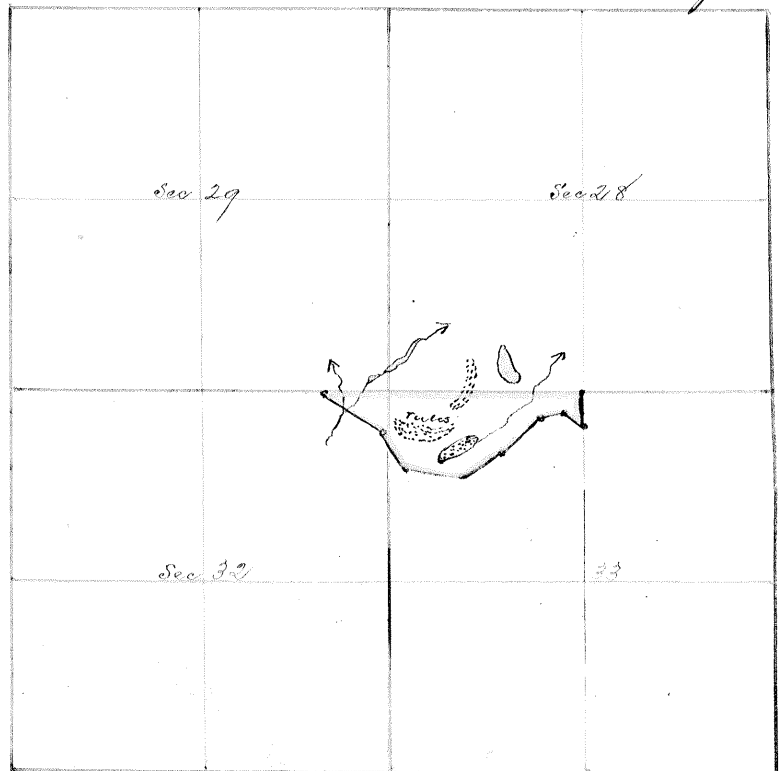

Field Notes.

Beginning at the corner sections 28, 29, 32 & 33, Township 3, South range 7 East Mt Diablo Meridian; thence east 40 ch. to quarter section corner on line between sections 28 & 33, thence south ^{9.25 ch.} to a post set at intersection of U.S. meander line in left margin of San Joaquin river; thence along said meander line down stream N 41° W 58.8 ch., N 79° W 6 ch., N 43° W 10 ch., N 52½° W 9 ch., N 81° W 13 ch., N 23° W 9 ch., N 58° W 13 chains to meander corner on the E & W line between sections 32 & 29; thence East 13 chains to point of beginning.

Run by the true meridian, Magnetic Variation 15° 45' E.

Surveyed in accordance with the act of the Legislature concerning Swamp and Overflowed Lands, approved April 18th 1859, and the instruction of the Surveyor-General.
